

Excel shortcuts

Create a new workbook:	Open an existing workbook:	Save a workbook:

Auto total sum: highlight the numbers to add plus an empty cell and press alt +	current time: ctrl+shift+; (in an empty cell)	current date: ctrl+; (in an empty cell)
Minimize the workbook window: Ctrl+F9	Create a bar chart based on selected data (on a separate sheet) F11
