Word shorcuts

Create a new document:

Ctrl+N

Open an existing document:

Ctrl+O

Save a document:

Ctrl+S

Open the Save As dialog box:

F12

Close a document:

Ctrl+W

Undo an action:

Ctrl+Z

Redo an action:

Ctrl+Y

Highlight words & apply bold formatting:

Ctrl+B

Highlight words & apply italic formatting:

Ctrl+I

Highlight words & apply underline formatting:

Ctrl+U

Apply underline formatting but not the spaces:

Ctrl+Shift+W

Print Preview View:

Ctrl+F2

Apply double underline formatting:

Ctrl+Shift+D

Decrease or increase font size:

Ctrl+Shift+< or >

Formats all letters as uppercase:

Ctrl+Shift+A

Formats all letters as lowercase:

Ctrl+Shift+K

Run a spelling and grammar check:

F7

Open the thesaurus.

If you have a word selected,
Shift+F7 looks up that word
in the thesaurus.:

Shift+F7
